**Identification and implementation of community local economic development projects for the period 2015 to 2020**

Our previous correspondence as well as the discussions at the Dipaleseng/Sasol Quarterly SLP LED Forum meeting on 21 August 2014 has reference.

Thank you for providing a list of proposed community local development (LED) projects for inclusion into Sasol Mining's Social and Labour Plan (SLP) for the period 2015 to 2020. As you are aware the current agreement with the Dipaleseng Municipality continues until 2017, during which the upgrade of the Nthoroane water treatment plant will be undertaken.

In respect of the period 2018 to 2020 the Dipaleseng/Sasol SLP LED Forum has identified the provision of sewer reticulation in Nthoroane/Senzele/Willemsdal/Greylingstad as the project to be implemented. This project forms a natural extension of sewer reticulation once the upgrade of waste water treatment plant has been completed. The total cost of the project is estimated at R55 million of which Sasol Mining will contribute an amount of R30 million. The balance of the funds could be sourced through Municipal Infrastructure or Department of Human Settlement grants and the Dipaleseng Municipality will explore this avenue of funding.

Please also convey our sincere gratitude and appreciation for the professional manner in which the representatives of the Dipaleseng Municipality officials are engaging with Sasol Mining.


