


PLAN 7: INFRASTRUCTURE



INFRASTRUCTURE

- Water**
- Out of 11 750 households, 9050 households have access to water and only 2700 do not have access to water.
- Sanitation**
- Out of 11 750, no residence use the bucket system, 700 are in the process of eradication, 9050 households have proper sanitation and only 2000 have no access to sanitation.
- Electricity**
- Out of 10 472 households, 9000 have been earmarked for free basic electricity (FBE) by the municipality, 400 FBE by Eskom and the backlog is estimated to be 2910.
- Roads**
- The national road N3 from Johannesburg to Durban is a first order road which is highly mobile and is well maintained.
 - The provincial roads R23 and R51 are not in good condition. Heavy trucks transporting coal destroy these roads and they therefore require constant maintenance.
 - Other secondary roads linking various farms and settlements within Dipaleseng are not in good condition, some are gravel roads and the tarred roads need upgrade.
